Handbills and stickers would be reaching every corner of Bangalore and would mean added publicity for the sponsor and for SFP.

The Event

Called **Light a Candle for Peace** our demonstration will have over 3000 students from 60 schools and colleges in Bangalore assembling on the 13th of February on M.G. Road at 5.30 p.m. The participants will form a human chain all along the road beginning at Mahatma Gandhi's statue and ending at Trinity circle.

At dusk, candles held by the students will be lit at one end and the flame passed along till it reaches the other end.

This would symbolically denote the reaching out of one fellow human being to another in friendship and communal harmony.

Logistics

A core group of students from SFP are already contacting educational institutions personally in an attempt at involving more people in the actual organizing of the event. Various educational institutions and voluntary organizations have already extended their support.

In order to make this event successful we need to launch a larger, more extensive publicity campaign.

Publicity Campaign – Details

Posters

Catchy posters by student artists from the Karnataka Chitrakala Parishad and other colleges will be printed and displayed in colleges and schools.

Banners

Participating institutions will be given publicity banners to be put up in their campuses.

Handbills

10,000 handbills in personalized form will be distributed among the students by the volunteers.

Stickers

5,000 stickers will be used for display on automobiles, windows of shops, etc.
